

Author's Guide

Manuscript requirements for the journal Haditechnika

The obligatory elements of the publication

- The title;
- Name of author(s);
- Academic degree, places of employment, scope of activities, e-mail and ORCID ID of author(s) (information and registration of ORCID: <http://openaccess.mtak.hu/index.php/kiadoknak/orcid> illetve <https://orcid.org/register>);
- Not more than 250-550 characters (3-6 lines) of abstract and 5 keywords;
- The explanation of abbreviations and acronyms immediately after the first occurrence;
- References (only the cited references can be listed in the Bibliography) and signed with Arabic number in square brackets;
- Expected form of references must be refer to Chicago Manual of Style vol. 17 (manual: https://www.chicagomanualofstyle.org/tools_citationguide/citation-guide-1.html);
- Only metric units and prefixes can be used in the text and the tables (original units with their SI conversions where appropriated).

Volume requirement

- Not more than 20.000-25.000 characters of text (spaces included);
- Volume includes captions and text of references;
- Manuscripts expected font is Times New Roman 12 justified.

Following about the author(s) must be indicated in the footnotes

- The academic degree and ORCID ID of author(s);
- Places of employment and other institutional affiliations.

Figures, tables and illustrations

- Illustrations are only accepted in the same language as the language of the article;
- Illustrations must be signed and placed in the right place in the text;
- Illustrations are also expected in separated high-resolution (at least 300 DPI) .jpg files;
- All figures, tables and illustrations must be referred in the text;
- Compliance with the copyright is the responsibility of the author(s);
- For applying formulas in the text MathType should be used;
- Captions must be created by the author(s);
- Captions must consist the source and as more information as possible.

The editorial board accepts only first-published articles and studies. An exception to this is if it has already been published in another periodical in another language, but in this case it must be referred back (indicate the fact of the second communication in a footnote).

The rights and obligations of copyrights and the honorarium are regulated by the publishing contract (HM Zrínyi Kiadó).

All the submitted manuscripts will be checked by two independent lectors and also will be scanned for plagiary.

Articles published in the journal Haditechnika will be uploaded to the Magyar Tudományos Művek Tára (Collection of Hungarian Scientific Works) by the editorial staff and also archived into the repository of MTA REAL-J.

The order of submitting manuscripts

- Manuscripts must be submitted at least two months before the planned publish;
- Manuscripts should be sent to haditechnika@hm.gov.hu;
- Illustrations also should be sent in numbered separated high-resolution files;

After the unanimous opinion of the lectors the manuscript will be accepted by the editorial staff and a Statement of Acceptance will be issued if appropriated.
